Navigators & Assisters


Navigators play a vital role in helping consumers prepare electronic and paper applications to establish eligibility and enroll in coverage through the Marketplace.

In Louisiana, Navigators are certified by the Federal government, licensed by the LA Dept. of Insurance and have undergone rigorous training, criminal background checks, and fingerprinting prior to assisting consumers.

The Federally-Facilitated Marketplace has designated organizations to certify application counselors who perform many of the same functions as Navigators, completely free at no cost to the consumer – including educating consumers and helping them complete their application for coverage. These groups include Louisiana's Federally Qualified Health Centers as well as other community health centers, health care providers, hospitals, or social service organizations.

Licensed agents and brokers assist consumers in applying for qualified health plans (QHPs) and insurance affordability programs including premium tax credits and cost-sharing reductions. They play a crucial role in educating consumers about the Health Insurance Marketplaces, both during annual open enrollment and throughout the coverage year.





Louisiana Consumers With Plan Selection as of 1/16/2016




Open Enrollment for 2016 coverage (OE3) began on November 1 and runs through January 31. Consumers who wanted coverage to start on January 1, 2016, needed to enroll by December 15. Due to unprecedented consumer demand in the days leading up to December 15, CMS extended the deadline for January 1 coverage to December 17 for the 38 states that use HealthCare.gov.

Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selection & Distribution by Enrollment Type






Louisiana Consumers Reenrolling in Marketplace Coverage



Total Completed Applications & Individuals




Total Marketplace Eligibility Determinations, and Marketplace Plan Selections




Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selections by Financial Assistance

Plan Selection with Financial Assistance Status




Plan Selection by Type of Financial Status



Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selection by Age and Gender


Marketplace Selection by Age


Marketplace Selection by Gender

As of 12/26/2015




Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selection by Metal Levels




Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selection by Reported Race/Ethnicity & Rural Status


Marketplace Plan Selection by Self-Reported Race/Ethnicity



Marketplace Plan Selection by Rural Status in Louisiana




Louisiana Marketplace Plan Selection by Household Income


